6th grade: 1st place Oshkosh North, 2nd place Stevens Point, 3rd place Sun Prairie, 4th place Minnesota Ballers


7th grade: 1st place Osseo Maple-Grove, 2nd place Oshkosh North, 3rd place Onalaska, 4th place Marshfield
