

American Legion Meeting and Banquet Policies

1. The American Legion reserves the right to require a security/cleaning deposit at the time of booking. The deposit will be applied to the bill accordingly.
2. The use of glitter, confetti, and aerosol foam string is prohibited.
3. The American Legion is not responsible for damage or loss of any merchandise, articles of clothing or personal belongings during or following the function.
4. Hanging of banners and posters is not permitted on the Memoriam.
5. Disc Jockey service and bands are required to end their music promptly by midnight. Volume should be appropriate level. Club Management reserves the right to control the volume levels at any point during the event as it is deemed necessary.
6. Any deliveries or outside set-up activities must be confirmed through the General Manager one week prior to the date.
7. All food and beverage prices are subject to change. Menus/prices must be confirmed no later than fourteen (14) days to event.
8. Menu selections and estimated attendance must be confirmed no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the event.
9. Confirmation of the guaranteed number of guests for attendance and each entrée served for meal functions needed 10 days in advance of the scheduled function. Once confirmed, these numbers may not be reduced. Charges will be assessed on the guaranteed minimum guest count, if count is not reached. If the number of guests exceeds the guaranteed guest count, we will accommodate the additional guest; however, no guarantees are made as to the availability of space or product. If you do not meet your banquet guarantee, we do not allow you to take extra meals, so please make sure your count is accurate.
10. The American Legion reserves the right to substitute an entrée of equal value to any guarantee increases. All charges will be assessed based upon the guarantee or the actual number of guests, whichever is greater
11. Due to strict Health Department codes, **no food or beverage** may be removed from the premises with the exception of the wedding cake.
12. All food and beverage products must be purchased from the American Legion, with the only exception being the wedding cake.
13. All prices are subject to an 18% (eighteen percent) service charge and applicable state and county tax. If requesting a tax exemption, you must submit a tax exemption certificate at least five (5) business days prior to the scheduled function in order to be approved for tax exemption status.
