Committee and Officer's Report

The **treasurer's report** indicated an actual balance in the checking account as of 2/10/19 of \$5,586.74. The expenses paid out were \$1,214.24. The revenues were \$1.17. A motion was made by Tanya Ellenbecker to accept the treasurers' report, a second by Randalyn Ellenbecker, all were in favor, and motion passes.

Principal's report – The FOCE money is being used to upgrade the staff's computers. The 3-D printer club has started. The school is looking for a 5th/6th grade part time teacher/ part time IT person.

Old Business –
