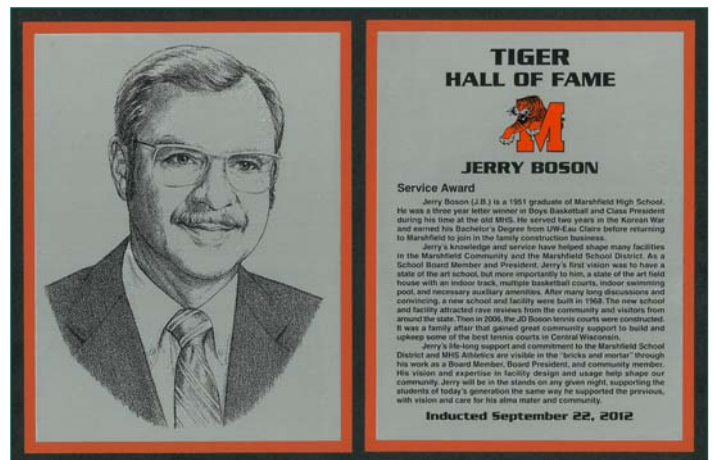
LDS Church, Stevens Point, WI

More than 80,000 square feet of production, freezer, employee locker and break room, dry storage, and shipping/receiving areas are under construction to accommodate the company's continued growth. Building enclosure is scheduled prior to winter's arrival and a 2013 completion is planned.
