Scope and Purpose:

Create, maintain, and update production part and tooling drawings of various complexity using customer drawings, sketches, existing products, and verbal direction.

Principle Duties and Areas of Responsibility:

- Create and update production models and prints for use on the shop floor.
- Create and maintain operational inspection templates in conjunction with production prints.
- Assist Design Engineers by detailing tool design prints.
- Create models and prints as needed to assist Estimating and Manufacturing Engineers.
- Maintain and update plant layout drawings.
- Adjust for changing priorities per customer requirements (internal & external) to maintain established deadlines. Manage workload using defined ERP schedule as well as hardcopy hand offs and offline instructions.
- Create models and prints from concept sketches and verbal communication.
- Train team members to meet established standards.
- Communicate effectively with internal and external customers verbally, through sketches, and in writing.
- Follow all defined policies and procedures in company handbook and other documents.
- Follow guidelines in department manuals.
- Demonstrate a professional attitude when approaching work assignments.
- Display a sense of urgency towards completing assigned tasks on time.
- Assist in developing timely solutions to problems.
- Maintain outstanding attendance.
- Perform other assigned duties as required.

Education:

 Individual must possess vocational degree in drafting and/or 5 years of CAD drafting experience in related field. Individual must have experience creating and modifying drawings from written and verbal instructions. Background needed in reading and interpreting complex drawings and redline changes, along with experience working with computers.



Skills and Abilities:

- Individuals must possess knowledge of materials and processes related to the company's manufactured product. Must be able to manage multiple priorities and complex tasks, often conflicting in nature, to reach commitment dates. The ability to read and interpret complex specifications is required. Must have excellent knowledge and experience with 3D modeling and print creation using Solidworks as well as a good understanding of 2D drafting with experience using AutoCAD or Draftsight.
- Previous experience with production inspection techniques and tools is a plus.

Communication Skills

 The drafter must possess effective communication skills, written and verbal, to work closely with product development team members, project managers, manufacturing team members, team leaders and buyers. Must communicate effectively and maintain good contact externally with vendors.

Mathematical Skills

 Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals. Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent.

Reasoning Ability

 Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists. Ability to interpret a variety of specifications and information furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.
