St. Paul Parish - Director of Religious Education Responsibilities

Encourage and promote the spiritual development of the catechists, students and volunteers of the program.

Pastoral Staff member: Share with Pastor and Education committee the responsibility of vision for the Faith Formation program.

Faith Formation Grades One-Ten

- Plan, organize, and direct all aspects of the Faith Formation program including registering of students, collecting tuition and communicating with the parish office information on registered students.
- Coordinate instruction of homeschooled Faith Formation students
- Coordinate the sacramental programs of Reconciliation/Eucharist/Confirmation including planning and implementation of retreat days for First Eucharist students (Jesus Day) and Confirmation students and parent sacramental meetings.
- Coordinate instruction of children who are in need of sacraments, but not enrolled in grade offered.
- Recruit catechists and provide in-service opportunities for growth in their knowledge of the faith and spiritual life.
- Evaluate, purchase and maintain program resources including texts, workbooks, Bibles, and other necessary classroom materials.
- Communicate regularly with parents of Faith Formation students and school parents of children in sacramental programs.
- Coordinate the Sacrament of Confirmation with St. Francis Xavier, Knowlton, St. John, Peplin and St. Patrick, Halder.
- Communicate with school staff regarding the use of classrooms and other facilities.
- Insure that all volunteers follow safe environment guidelines
- Coordinate the use of the facilities and equipment for Religious Education programs
- Adhere to the Diocesan policy on Teaching of the Way of Love and Theology of the Body

R.C.I.A.

- Participate on the RCIA team which includes leading sessions as needed.
- Accompanying RCIA candidates on retreats
- Accompanying RCIA candidates to the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion held at St. Joseph the Workman Cathedral

Sunday Story

- Order supplies including print materials as requested by Sunday Story Leader
- Insure that all leaders follow the safe environment guidelines.

Youth Ministry program and bible study

- Consult with leaders of the youth group and provide resources as requested by youth leaders.
- Insure that all leaders follow the safe environment guidelines.

Vacation Bible School

- Evaluate and purchase materials for program.
- Recruit volunteers to help with program
- Insure that all volunteers follow safe environment guidelines

Safe Environment

 Keep records of Diocesan Safe Environment requirements including background checks, permission forms and volunteer driver forms. Submit required reports to Diocesan Safe Environment Office.

Adult Education

- Evaluate needs of the parish as they relate to adult education.
- Consult with Pastor regarding the adult education needs of the parish.
- Coordinate parish adult education programs
- Maintain the parish library.

Professional/Spiritual Formation

- Attend annual Diocesan Catechetical Conference.
- Participate in monthly Wausau Deanery Religious Education Leaders (WDREL) group
- Participate in periodic Diocesan Association of Religious Educators (DARE) meetings and professional and spiritual development opportunities
- Participate in periodic Wisconsin Directors of Religious Education Federation meetings and Professional and spiritual development opportunities.
- Participate in opportunities for self-growth and enrichment; retreat and convention

Parish Committees

- Participate in scheduled parish education committee
- Attend monthly parish council meetings.
