Mike Schueller will still chair the Expo 2-11-21 thru 2-13-21

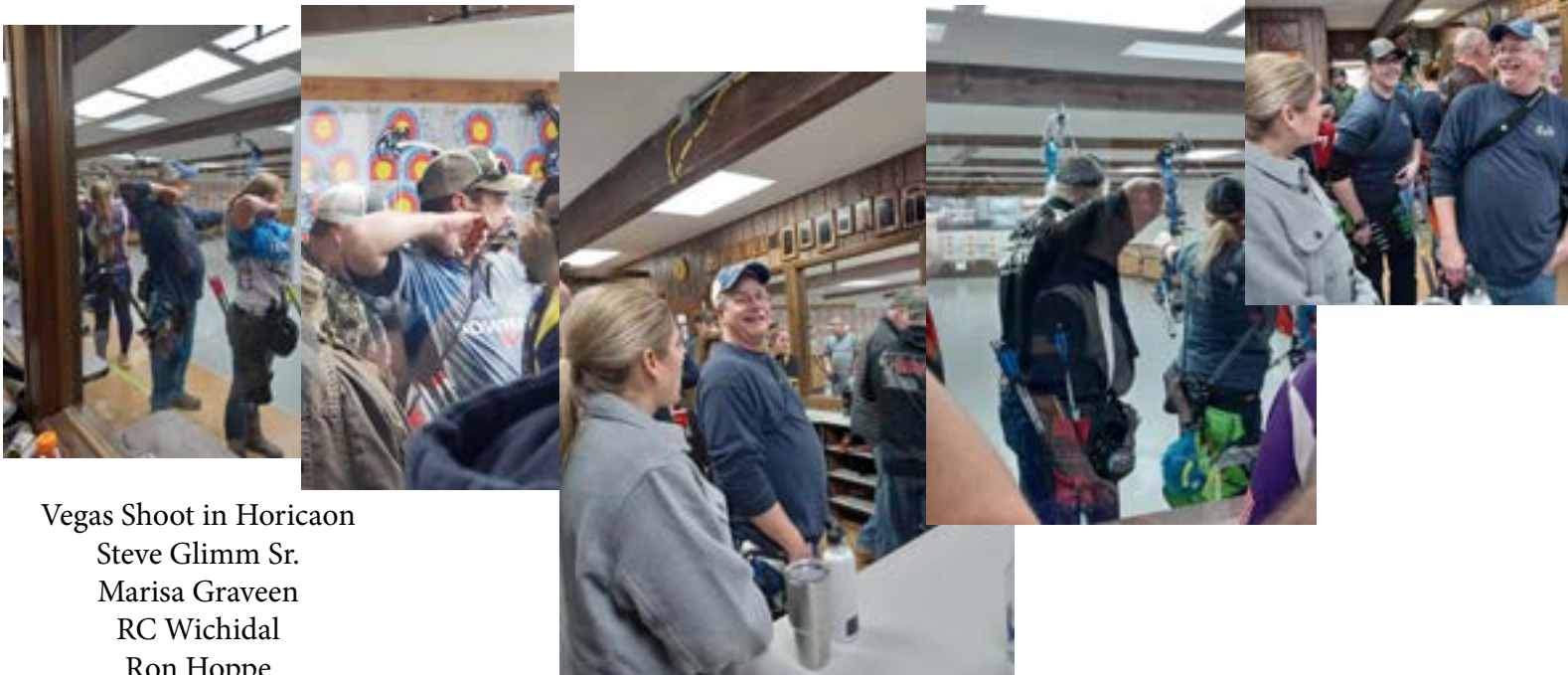
Lights outdoor - Mike Dalenbach to call WPS
