Tom Bartz president called meeting at 7:00 PM CST to order followed by the pledge of allegiance.

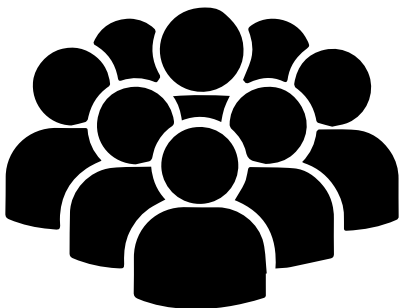
Secretary Report: A motion was made by Paul Shore to accept the secretary's report as distributed, seconded by Marcell Wieloch, motion carried
