#### <u>Old Business</u>

- **Building Committee Updates** Lindsay Kalenske said we have the blueprints far enough along and Tony Heil presented to several different contractors and we are working on getting estimates on costs.
- Ron Hoppe said Sue Nelson posted on Facebook that they will be teaching at the seminar and it's all about grant writing and how to write letters. Paul Shore will be attending 1/20/22 workshop. - As a committee, we discuss in hiring someone to write the grants and we would include in the grant money. We are thinking we may be asking for \$1-2 million dollars, so we need someone with experience. If there is a cost upfront for this and may have to have a special meeting for approval from members and board.

#### January 2022 Traditional Shoot at RMB

We had a good January 8 & 9, 2022 Traditional Shoot, recurves or long bows or self bows, at our club. This shoot has only been canceled due to Covid in 2020. The first Traditional Only Shoot was in 1992 and for the development of the Wisconsin Traditional Archers and George Henrich Sr. He is a member of our club and one of the co-founders of the Wisconsin Traditional Archers.

There are still at least 19 Traditional Only Shoots for 2022 and most are those are mini-rendezvous with not just archery, but camping out and sharing of food around campsites and refreshments. Rib Mountain Bowmen has one of those in August and you will see the park-ing/camping area totally full with RV's. Travel trailers or tent campers with vehicles parked up the road. Come out and see the fun in archery and we do offer traditional equipment to use for the day and there is always a few to help out.

Our January 2022 shoot turned in \$909.00 to the club and we always have 14-3D targets outdoors and 14-3D targets indoors. Since the time I have chaired or co-chaired the shoot we have had -23° temperatures and then some three feet of snow. Traditional Archers always turn out. This year we have another outdoor shoot added at the Horicon Marsh Bowmen for January 22 and then the Janesville Bowmen hold a Chili Shoot on March 5. Last year Janesville registration topped out at 99.

A big thank you for those club volunteers and one non-member to help set up the outside and inside course; to serve the food for the two days; to tear down the outside course and to initially walk around the course, some four times, with snowshoes.
