 - Recap of HHAUSA Honor Flight Shoot - Erin Witucki emailed the updates.
 - Thank you for everyone that came out and helped, bid on raffle items, and shot at the event! It was a success!
 - We had 85 shooters on the regular course and 28 participants in the Saturday night scramble.
 - The following was raised during our weekend.
 - o \$1695 - 3D Shoot Fees
 - o \$700 - Scramble Fees
 - o \$679 - Bar/Food
 - o \$530 - Long-Shot
 - o \$3,975 - Silent Auction
- TOTAL: \$7,579

- HHA USA – retained \$6,879 that will be passed along to Honor Flight and other veteran charitable organizations.
- \$420 was paid out to 6 teams – winners of scramble.
- \$280 of the scramble proceeds + \$192 of additional donations = \$472 was donated directly to the Patriot K-9's
- We made a great connection with Patriot K-9s of Wisconsin, they sent out a puppy in training and the executive director on Saturday and the president of the board, Gilbert came out Sunday and stayed for a few hours. He took a tour of the club and visited with those at the shoot, even jumped in and served up a few hot dogs.
- o If the Coffee Clutch group is ever looking for someone to come out – these guys would love to bring out a dog and come chat with the group. They have an extreme passion for helping veterans and this program and it is amazing to hear about everything these dogs can do.
- Mike Schueller was awarded the “Straight N’ Arrow Award” from HHS USA – for his dedication to our club, community and love for the sport.



- **Youth League** - Ron Hoppe gave update average about 10-15 boys and girls the last night they set up 6 or 8 3D targets and took turn keeping score. Rotated through all the targets and then all the adults shot at an apple turn came inside and had a potluck. They saw great improvements in the kids shooting. 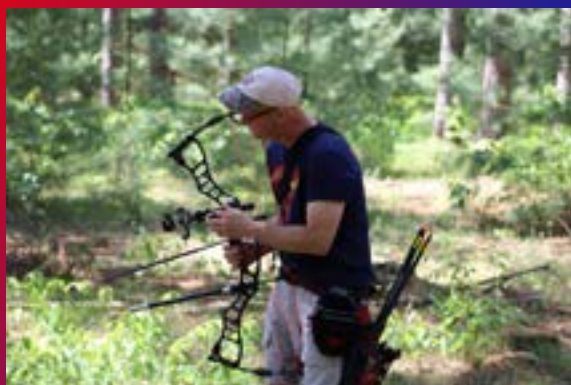

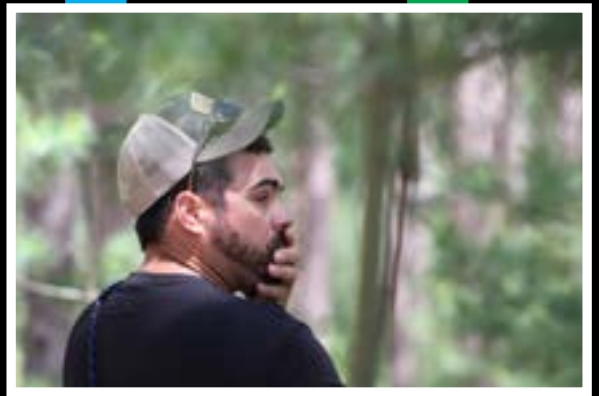
