Fun Fact(s) about Archery:

The oldest know Neolithic bow that was discovered in Europe belongs to the period of 7,400-7,200 yeast before present. The intact bow was dug out from anaerobic layers. Made of yew wood, this specimen was only 1.08 meters long with a D-shaped cross-section.

Archery was the first Olympic sport to allow female competitors. The Olympic Games can be traced back to 776 B.C., but they didn't allow women to compete in the Games till 1904.

Wausau Alternative High School Students Return to RMB

After being canceled in 2020 because of the COVID epidemic the program which gives students attending the Wausau School District's Alternative High School the opportunity to learn how to shoot bows and arrows resumed in April of 2021. The number of sessions was reduced to three (from four or six as in previous years) because of late approval from the school's administration. Eight students accompanied by two faculty members received one-on-one instruction from eight RMB members. Mike Brust, Harry Borquin, Mike Drengler, George Henrich Senior, Paul Shore, Marcell Wieloch, Herb Wheeler and Tom Woods had the pleasure of serving as mentors to these fine, young people. This brings the total number of students who participated in this partnership to forty-one since its inception in 2017.

Each session included a mid-way break period in order to give tired, previously seldom used muscles a chance to rest and relax. Not wanting to miss the opportunity to take advantage of their captive audience, several mentors used these breaks to present mini-seminars on various aspects of archery: George gave a demonstration on arrow making, Mike B. and Marcell spoke on turkey calling and hunting, and Paul gave a presentation on bowfishing.

While the purpose of the program was to introduce the students to archery, the school's instructors said that more importantly the students learned companionship, commitment, punctuality, respect, team work, and fellowship while building self-confidence. They went on to say "It has really made a difference in the lives of several of the students" and "it is more beneficial than you will ever know."

We are looking forward to changing lives one arrow at a time again next year and hope to have more club members join us.....it changed our lives, too.
