Secretary report - A motion was made by Marcell Wieloch to accept


the secretary's report as distributed, seconded by Liz Woodward, motion carried

Benefits to the PAGE vs GROUP and why it is important to have the page – the page/business can be tagged, as you can see today – HHAUSA tagged us in a post, in that post people can click on the link and it will take them direct to our page. That feature was unavailable with the group and the biggest issue with it. The page/business can create events – like board meetings, raffle party, shoots and someone can easily access those through the page. This page now had multiple admin (Ross, myself, Liz), if anyone else wants to be an admin Ross can add you – when you visit the page, you then post as "Rib Mountain Bowmen, Inc." rather than yourself.

Ideally – we would like to get everyone that liked those other pages to also 'like' this page. We have some work to do to meet that goal. What the members can do to make this happen?...(you can ignore this next part if you aren't a Facebook person!)

- Post to the page, keep it active and interesting
- Like/share posts from the page to your personal page
- Tag the page in your hunting and archery posts @ribmountainbowmen
- Invite your friends to the page
- Respond to the events, even if you don't plan on attending respond as 'interested'.
- Something to maybe discuss at the board meeting, a lot of business' grow their FB 'likes' by doing a drawing. In order to get entry into the drawing, someone has to 'like' our page and share it (requiring them to


Since we all found out about changes through the board meeting minutes it is just as appropriate for the changing over of the
