APRIL IS NATIONAL CAR CARE MONTH

National Car Care Month is here! Winter weather can wreak havoc on vehicles both internally and externally which is why it's critical to give your vehicle proper attention and maintenance at the change of seasons.

Basic maintenance can go a long way toward improving the safety and dependability of your vehicle, plus it helps avoid costly repairs down the road. National Car Care Month in April is the perfect time to focus on your vehicle's maintenance needs.

Most vehicle owners could save money by being more proactive when it comes to their vehicle. Whether you do it yourself or bring your car to an Auto Select professional service technician, make sure your car is ready for the spring and summer travel season.

Here are 10 basic maintenance procedures to keep your car operating at its best:

1. Check the oil, filters, and fluids. Brake, transmission, power steering, coolant and windshield washer fluids too. Your car's filters, including those for the transmission, fuel system and interior ventilation, need regular inspection as well.
2. Inspect hoses at each oil change and have them replaced when leaking, brittle, cracked, rusted, swollen or restricted.
3. Check the brake system every year and have the brake pads, shoes, rotors and drums inspected at each oil change.
4. Check that the battery connection is clean, tight and corrosion-free. The battery should be securely mounted. If it is three years old or more, the battery should be tested and replaced if necessary.
5. Inspect the exhaust system for leaks, damage and broken supports or hangers if there is an



unusual noise. Exhaust leaks can be dangerous and must be corrected without delay.

6. Schedule a tune-up that will help the engine deliver the best balance of power and fuel economy and produce the lowest level of emissions.

7. Check the car's heating, ventilating and air conditioning (HVAC) system as proper heating and cooling performance is critical for interior comfort and for safety reasons.

8. Inspect the steering and suspension system annually, including shock absorbers and struts, and chassis parts, such as ball joints, tie rod ends and other related components.

9. Check the pressure of all tires, including the spare, at least once a month. Check the tread for uneven or irregular wear and cuts and bruises along the sidewalls. Have your car's alignment checked at least annually to reduce tire wear and improve fuel economy and handling.

10. Test exterior and interior lights and have bulbs that are not working checked immediately. Replace windshield wiper blades every six months or when cracked, cut, torn, streaking or chattering for optimum wiping performance and safety.

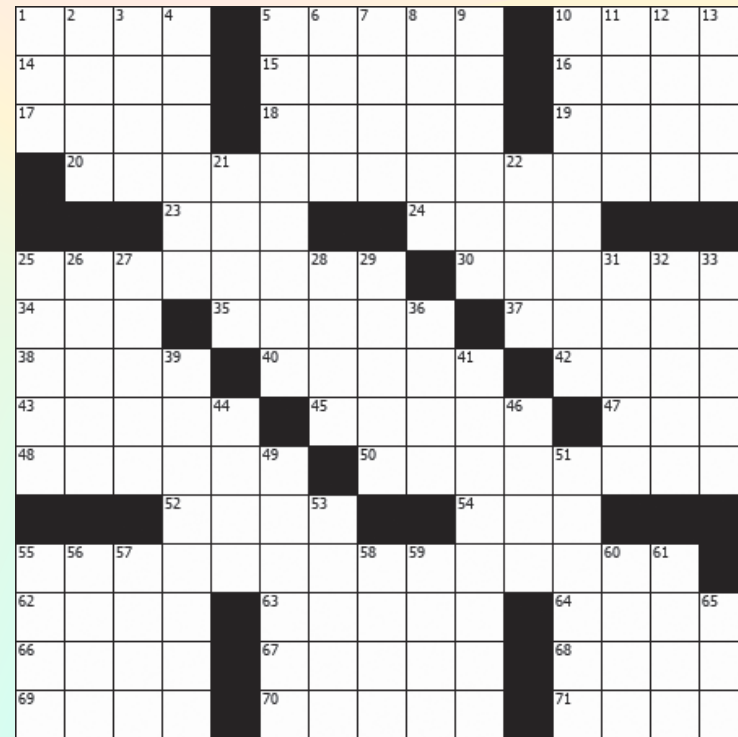

Peanut Butter and Candy Egg Blondies

INGREDIENTS:

Cooking spray

1 1/4 c. all-purpose flour,
spooned and leveled

1 1/4 c. honey-roasted peanuts

1 tsp. baking powder

1/2 tsp. kosher salt

1 1/2 c. packed light brown sugar

1/2 c. (1 stick) unsalted butter, at
room temperature

1 c. creamy peanut butter

2 tsp. pure vanilla extract

2 large eggs

1 (12-ounce) bag peanut butter
pastel eggs, divided

3/4 c. semisweet chocolate chips

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350°F. Line a 9-by-13-inch baking pan with parchment paper. Lightly grease paper.

Place flour and peanuts in a food processor. Process until peanuts are broken down and blended with flour,
30 to 45 seconds. Add baking powder and salt; pulse to combine, 2 to 3 times.

Beat sugar and butter with an electric mixer on medium speed until light and fluffy, 2 to 4 minutes. Beat in peanut
butter, vanilla, and eggs until incorporated, 1 to 2 minutes. Gradually beat in flour mixture just until combined.

Set aside 3/4 cup peanut butter eggs. Stir chocolate chips and remaining peanut butter eggs into batter.

Transfer batter to prepared pan. Scatter reserved peanut butter eggs on top. Bake until puffed, edges are deep
golden brown, and a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, 25 to 30 minutes. Cool in pan on a wire rack.
Cut into 24 bars.
