A Few Reminders...

- 1) Trinity is able to participate in the USDA Seamless Summer Option for serving school lunches. That means that **ALL students are eligible to receive free school lunches**. We will also be offering free meals to any siblings of students (18 years or young) enrolled in Trinity as carry-outs. **IMPORTANT** – this program is scheduled to last until December 31st OR until the funding runs out.
- 2) We have implemented a new safety procedure for **after school pick-up**. All students being picked up are to stand and wait on the concrete pad outside the back door until the adult releases them.
- 3) Until further notice, school children will not be **singing in church as a group on the 2nd Sunday of each month** as they've done in the past.
- 4) Mrs. Strack will be here every Wednesday mornings before Chapel to collect money for the **Y.I. (Young Investors) Savings Program**. Students are able to start a book with as little as 25 cents, or continue with the book you may have started in the past. If you have a book at home, please bring it in. Interest is compounded and currently at 2%, up to \$1,000 or 18 years of age. It's a great way to start saving!

*Keep in mind.... **School tuition** paid in 2020-21 may be claimed as a State tax deduction. Be sure to save your monthly statements as your receipt. Talk with your tax preparer when completing your tax return.*

Busing to AHS OR to a Friend's House: After school busing to AHS for sports activities is only allowed if your child already has a “seat” on his/her bus. Please be sure to send a note with your child to give to the bus driver stating that he / she has your permission to get off the bus at the high school. The busing company is not able to allow busing to a friend's house at this time.
