Mask Policy Modification: At the April meeting of the Board of Christian Education it was decided to slightly modify our mask requirement policy. After reviewing current covid conditions, it was decided to keep the mask requirement in place. The following factors were considered:

- staff are not fully vaccinated at this time (1 or 2 vaccinations received)
- CDC, Wisconsin Health Dept, and Marathon County all still recommend wearing masks
- social distancing is not always possible in school

However, the following modification were added. Teachers may at their discretion allow for short mask "breaks" (10-15min) throughout the day. These breaks can only happen when the following conditions can be met.

- Students are seated and will remain seated
- Students are able to be socially distanced
- Teachers able to remain socially distanced from the students.

(i.e. students are taking a test, students are reading quietly at their desks)

The Board of Christian Education will continue to monitor Covid 19 conditions and will review current policies at their monthly meetings.
